- **Perform permanent measurement of SG-SST (Occupational Health and Safety)** results in order to verify compliance with the objectives and strive for the continuous improvement of the System.
- **Allocate and maintain the human, technical, physical and financial resources** necessary to achieve the objectives and goals proposed in the Occupational Health and Safety System.

The commitments acquired by the organization involve our collaborators, regardless of their contract type or involvement, including contractors and subcontractors, providing a safe and healthy environment and who will have the responsibility to comply with this policy, through participation and commitment, performing safe work in alignment with the following premises in **preventive culture for health and safety at work 24/7:**

- 1 If the task to be executed **is not safe, it is not executed**. The tasks must be executed **under controlled risk conditions**.
- 2 Every incident or accident at work **can be prevented**.
- 3 Safety **and health at work** must be **a value**, not just a priority.
- 4 **Stopping a job when a risk** is identified is both **a responsibility and a duty**.
- 5 **Act** together to **build a preventive health and safety culture**, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
